We have reviewed/learned, greetings (good morning, good afternoon, etc.) common phrases in Spanish (What's your name? How are you?, How old are you? With their answers, etc.)

We made booklets with the common phrases, words, questions, etc. that I would expect my students to use during class. They will keep them in their desks so they can use them any time during class and start speaking more Spanish.

We started using our text books "Muy Bien" level B. We finished our first lesson "La Escuela" (the school), studying greetings, some classroom objects, review colors, numbers (1-20), the article the in singular form (el, la). We are currently studying lesson 2 "Materiales de la clase" (classroom materials) covering more classroom materials.

We also learned about the Mexican Independence, we watched a video about the Mexican history. Ask your child to tell you some facts they learned about the topic.

I'm excited to share with you our new Spanish web site. You can find our newsletter, homework, songs, etc. You can also view what the other classes are doing. If your child loses the homework you can get it from the site and print it at home. The address is:
